



INVITATION TO TENDER

GREATER MANDEVILLE WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE 1B-7, OLD PEPPER WELL SITE TO GUTTERS RELIFT STATION TRANSMISSION MAIN REPLACEMENT, MANCHESTER

Procuring Entity: The National Water Commission

Description of Service: The works comprise the complete construction and testing of approximately 6km of 600mm (24") nominal diameter Ductile Iron Transmission pipeline from the Old Pepper Well Site to the Gutters Relift Station, together with the provision for numerous appurtenances of stated Contract Specifications and Conditions, for the Greater Mandeville Water Supply Improvement Project – Phase 1B-7.

Eligibility Requirements:

Tenderers must submit:

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
• A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission formerly (NCC) in the following category at the bid submission deadline:
✓ Pipe Laying, Grade 1 (minimum)
• Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
• Bid security in the correct amount and form
• A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the company's bid is not signed by a Director or Chief Executive Officer of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid Document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Tender documents can be downloaded as of Wednesday, September 7, 2022.
• Clarification period – no later than 7 working days (Monday, October 3, 2022) before bid submission deadline.

Submission Deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via GOJEP no later than Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by Thursday, October 13, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. at the following address:

The Rural Agricultural Development Authority (RADA) now invites Bids from eligible and qualified bidders to undertake the rehabilitation of farm roads in various parishes for this financial year. Three (3) such packages are:

- Package 1: Clarendon [Curatoo Hill to Parnassus Road, Cockpitt to Longville Park Road and Crawl Pass to Bois Content Road]
• Package 2: Trelawny [Stettin to Freemans Hall Road, Facey Town Road, Penn (Stettin) to Thompson Town Road and Joe Hut to Swamp Road]
• Package 3: Hanover [Content to Cacoon Castle Road, Old Pen to Chigwel Road and St. Simon to Lances River Road]

SCOPE OF WORK: The Contractor(s) will be required to undertake the rehabilitation of road pavements inclusive of but not limited to asphaltic double surface treatment, drainage improvement (culverts, kerb and channel), asphaltic concrete cross drains, surfacing and brushing of roadways.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TENDER:

National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Procurement Method will be used and bidders must submit the following along with their bids:

- Completed and signed Form of Bid (in the prescribed format).
• A valid Public Procurement Commission (PPC) Certificate in the category of General Roadworks – Grades 1-2 or Road Maintenance Work – Grades 1-2 (See http://www.ppc.gov.jm/ppc/),
• A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)
• Bid Security of \$45,420.00.
