Submission Deadline: Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm no later than Tuesday, October 31, 2023. Bid Opening will follow at 12:30 p.m. (Jamaica time)

Technical Support to Develop Complementary Training Curricula and Training Manuals on: Digitization, Digitalization and Digital Transformation for MSMEs

The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has received approval for the implementation of a Budget Support Programme (BSP) to be funded by the European Union ("the EU") for a Digital Transitioning Programme for Jamaica (Digital Jamaica).

Jamaica's Digital Agenda is in line with its ICT Policy, with its stated Mission "to achieve greater social & economic development, through increased application of ICT in all sectors". The associated activities are aimed inter alia, at scaling up e-government infrastructure and services across the country; facilitating accelerated technological adoption and innovation by the private sector; expanding digital competencies in the labour force and promoting a knowledge-based society.

A valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL), Public Procurement Commission (PPC) registration in the categories of Information Technology Services; and Computers and Related Services, if selected for contract award.

If any aspect of the contract will not be physically performed in Jamaica, the above is not a requirement for overseas bidders.

Bidding documents are available on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement (GOJEP) website - www.gojep.gov.jm. Registration instructions are also available on the website. Registration is required for consultants to participate in this tender opportunity.

Bid Submission and Opening:

Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm no later than Monday, November 13, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. (local time). An online bid opening will take place on the same date at 3:15 p.m. An online bid opening report will be sent to all bidders who submit a bid.

Late Bids will be automatically rejected by the system. No offline bids (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender box for drop-off of tender documents.
