Description of Service: The works consist of The Supply and Installation of approximately 950m and 1150m of 150mm dia. and 100mm dia. SDR 21 PVC pipes, respectively, and 500m of 50mm dia. G.I pipeline; together with the provision for numerous appurtenances of stated Contract Specifications and Conditions – Lewisville, St. Elizabeth."

Eligibility Requirements:

Tenderers must submit:

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
- A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission formerly (NCC) in any of the following classifications:
 - Pipe Laying (Grade 1)
- · Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
- Bid security in the correct amount and form
- A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the Company's bid is not signed by a Director or Chief Executive Officer of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid Document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal–GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Clarification period no later than 7 working days (Monday, October 30, 2023) before bid submission deadline.

Submission Deadline: Tenders must be submitted via the GOJEP no later than **Wednesday, November 8, 2023 at 11:00 a.m.**

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security **MUST** be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by **Thursday, November 9, 2023 at 11:00 a.m.** at the following address:
