The Office of the Governor-General and Staff, in accordance with the Public Procurement Act, 2015 and the Public Procurement Regulations, 2018, hereby invites suitably qualified firms to submit bids for the Renovation of the Bishop's Lodge Car Park at King's House, Kingston, Jamaica. Bidding will be conducted using the **National Competitive Bidding (NCB)** procurement methodology via the Government of Jamaica's eProcurement (GOJEP) System.

BACKGROUND

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

The proposed site is located at King's House Jamaica. The scope of works described in the Bills of Quantities is for the construction of an asphaltic concrete and grasscrete parking area. The works include for excavation and earthworks, 50mm thick asphaltic concrete, grasscrete pavers, drainage and other associated works.
