(ii) Must be able to provide eligible Key Experts that possess the requisite qualifications as per the Terms of Reference (TOR).

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: **Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank** GN-2350-15 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. For the purpose of establishing the short list, the nationality of a firm is that of the country in which it is legally incorporated or constituted and in the case of Joint Venture, the nationality of the firm appointed to represent it.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS)** method set out in the Consultant Policies.
