EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

The Government of Jamaica has received funding from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in the amount of US\$8,250,000 towards the cost of the Basic Needs Trust Fund Tenth Cycle (BNTF 10). The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF), as the executing agency, intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Grant to cover payments under contract for the following – **Special Education Roadmap for the Basic Needs Trust Fund (#73931)**.

Scope:

The consultancy will include:

1. An evaluation/impact assessment of projects financed under the BNTF Cycles 5-9 targeted towards special education (infrastructure & capacity building), including impact, gaps and opportunities for investment. The focus should not only be on children with physical disabilities, but also children with intellectual disabilities; those deaf/hard of hearing; blind/visually impaired and any other type of disability which affects the target group.
2. The development of a Special Education Roadmap for mainstreaming special education inclusion in BNTF project design.

The National Works Agency (NWA) invites sealed bids from eligible and suitably qualified contractors for the procurement of **ROAD REHABILITATION (GABION WALL CONSTRUCTION) SUTTONS, CLARENDON – MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC GROWTH & JOB CREATION - MAINTENANCE OF SECONDARY ROADS - F/Y 2024/2025**

Scope of Works: The work consists of but not limited to demolition and site clearance, earthworks to include excavation for foundation. Drainage facilities in HDPE pipe Culvert construction, Asphaltic concrete overlay (38mm thick). Further details on the specifications can be found in the Bills of Quantities and Technical Specification.
