EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

Procuring Entity: The National Water Commission

Description of Service: The works consist of the construction of a 264 Sq. ft Reinforced Concrete Control Building, approximately 240m of Barbwire perimeter fencing, approximately 75m of 150mm dia. DI pipeline, and Asphalt concrete driveway access and associated earth works; together with the provision for numerous appurtenances of stated Contract specifications and Conditions – Whitehall Well, St. Elizabeth.

Eligibility Requirements

Tenderers must submit:

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/ valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
- A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the following classification::
 - Civil Engineering (Grade 2)
- Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
- Bid security in the correct amount and form
- A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the Company's bid is not signed by a Director or Chief Executive Officer of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid Document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal–GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Tender documents can be downloaded as of **Wednesday**, **April 17, 2024.**
- Clarification period no later than 7 working days (Friday, May 17, 2024) before bid submission deadline.

Submission Deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via the GOJEP no later than Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by Wednesday, May 22, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. at the following address:
