EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 year. All interested financial suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

The Office of the Prime Minister (OPM), acting on behalf of the Government of Jamiaca, has received financing in the amount equivalent to US\$68,000,000.00 from the Inter-American Deveopment Bank (IDB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services in relation to the upgrade/improvement of the Government's Information and Communications Technology Infrastructure. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligbility rules and procedures.

The OPM now invites bids from eligible bidders for Procurement of Local Area Network (LAN) Infrastrcuture Installation at Enrolment Sites.

Bidding will be conducted through National Competitve Bidding procedures as specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for Procurement of Works and Goods financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN2349-9), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined.

Eligibility for Bid Submission

To establish eligibility, Bidders must comply with the following criteria at the time of bid submission:

- 1. Signed Bid Submission Form
- 2. Signed Bid Declaration Form

The successful Bidder, at the time of contract award, must possess a valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) and be registered with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the category Computers and Related Services OR Information Technology Services.

NB: Interested bidders are strongly encouraged to commence the registration processes during the tender period to minimize delays with contract execution upon receiving contract award notification.

Tender opening will be done electronically on the same day at 2:15 p.m. local time. An online bid opening report will be sent to all Bidders who submit a proposal. A bid security will not be required.
