EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

Description of Service: By way of National Competitive Bidding, the National Water Commission (NWC) is inviting local firms, with strong capabilities, experience and qualified personnel in Janitorial, Sanitation Services, to undertake Janitorial Services for NWC's Eastern, Western and Southern Locations for Three (3) Years (Lots 1-3) - Retender.

Eligibility Requirements

- Tenderers must submit:
• A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
• A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the following category:
- Janitorial, Sanitation Services
• Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
• Bid security in the correct amount and form
• A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the company's bid is not signed by a Director or Chief Executive Officer of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid Document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Tender documents can be downloaded as of Wednesday, May 1, 2024.
• Clarification period - no later than 7 working days (Monday, June 10, 2024) before bid submission deadline.

Submission Deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via the GOJEP no later than Wednesday, June 19, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by Thursday, June 20, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. at the following address:

Scope of Works: The works consist of but not limited to Demolition, Site Clearance, Drain Cleaning, Earthworks, Drainage Facilities, preparation and formation of pavement, rubble masonry parapet wall and coping, ancillary road works.
