EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

Scope: The project entails the construction of a reinforced concrete tank with a capacity of 30,000 imperial gallons. The scope of work includes excavation, form-work assembly, installation of reinforcement, concrete pouring, and finishing (material and labour), as specified in the bid document.

N.B: A tender security in the form of a bond or Bank Guarantee, stamped by the Commissioner of Stamp Duty in the amount of JA\$200,000.00 is required.

No offline (Hard Copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off box. **Deadline: Wednesday, October 2, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.**

The Government of Jamaica/Ministry of Health and Wellness, through the Kingston Public Hospital Rehabilitation Project, intends to undertake consulting services for contract award for **Design and Supervision Services for the Renovation of Intensive Care Units at the Kingston Public Hospital.**

The consulting services ("the Services") are for a consulting firm to provide Design and Supervision Services for the Renovation of Intensive Care Units at the Kingston Public Hospital. The activities will encompass Architectural, Civil/Structural, Mechanical/Electrical Quantity Surveying Services required for the overall renovation works involved with the comprehensive redesigning of the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) located at the Kingston Public Hospital (KPH) as detailed in the Terms of Reference (TOR).

ELIGIBILITY

The Ministry of Health and Wellness now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consulting firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. **The firm should meet the following criteria:**

- Company's Certificate of Incorporation**
- Valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)**
- Ten (10) years' similar and/or relevant experience in managing/supervising construction projects with similar scope of works related to the preparation of architectural, structural and detailed engineering designs, preparation of bid documents including Bill of Quantities and technical specifications. Experience in the public sector, especially in hospitals, would be considered an advantage.**
- Must be able to provide eligible Key Experts that possess the requisite qualification as per the Terms of Reference (TOR).**

This is an online Tender where tender documents, clarification and bid submission will only be made available and accepted via the **Government Electronic Procurement Portal – GOJEP** (www.gojep.gov.jm). Consulting firms will have to be registered on the GOJEP to participate in this procurement Opportunity.

The procurement methodology is Open Bidding by means of National Competitive Bidding as per the Public Procurement Act, 2015 and the Public Procurement Regulations. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)** methodology.
