**EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE** GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 year. All interested financial suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic submission and supplier account management.



Rehabilitation of Three Industrial Park Warehouses at Lyfdord, St. Ann, Jamaica W.I.

The Jamaica Bauxite Mining (JBM) Limited now invites bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the Rehabilitation of Three Industrial Park Warehouses at Lydford, St. Ann, Jamaica W.I.

SCOPE OF WORK: The renovation of three (3) existing steel framed warehouses with a total combined floor area of 62,053 ft2 (5,765 m2). The buildings shall comprise of areas for warehousing, office areas and bathroom facilities. The renovation works include the construction of concrete block walls for the building perimeter, the replacement and restoration of all defective structural steel members, restoration of concrete flooring, replacement of cladding to roofing and sidings with new metal sheeting, installation of new external windows and doors, shutters for loading areas and construction of entry canopies. The works shall also include the demolition and removal of internal walls, windows, doors and ceilings for creation of offices and bathrooms as well as the complete refurbishing of the electrical and ventilation systems. External works include parking and loading areas, installation of potable water storage and distribution as well as onsite sewage treatment.

For tenders to be eligible, the following documents must be presented at the time of bid submission:

- Valid Public Procurement Commission Certificate (PPC) registered in the category of BUILDING CONSTRUCTION -Grade 1
- Valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL)

Failure to provide ALL of the above shall result in the rejection of the bid submission.

Bids shall be valid for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days after the bid closing date. Bids must be submitted via the GOJEP on or before 2:00 p.m. Friday, January 31, 2025. Tenders will be opened via the GOJEP System at 2:15 p.m. Friday, January 31, 2025.
