EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's strengthen. commitment to promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration. electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

The Government of Jamaica successfully engaged the World Bank to extend and expand its 6-year US\$50 million loan facility called Foundation for Competitiveness and Growth Project (FCGP) to allow it to deepen the reform initiatives that had been supported under the Project. Approval was granted for the additional financing of an initial US\$10 million from the World Bank and the Government committed to provide a further US\$5 million, thus providing a total of US\$15 million to support the various government entities implementation of investment climate reforms.

The consulting services ("the Services")

The Planning Institute of Jamaica (PIOJ) is at the forefront of coordinating Jamaica's national development initiatives, including the implementation of various public investment projects. In recent years, Jamaica has made significant strides in public sector transformation, particularly through strategic public investment initiatives. However, a common challenge has been the fragmented approach to project management across various Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDAs). Many projects, especially those that are cross-cutting, spanning multiple sectors or development goals, do not neatly fall within the purview of a single MDA. These projects often face delays and inefficiencies due to the lack of a cohesive framework that can coordinate, monitor, and ensure their successful implementation.

Large-scale and multi-sectoral projects in particular have struggled with bottlenecks and issues related to resource allocation which have contributed to delays in implementation. Reports from the World Bank and other development agencies have highlighted concerns about low project completion rates and the need for more structured management frameworks to streamline the process.

In this regard, the consultant will analyse and develop the most effective operational framework for a Programme Management Office (PMO) in PIOJ to support select cross-cutting national programmes/ projects. The functions of the PMO are envisaged to be:

- Back-office fiduciary and technical support services to facilitate and support implementation of projects which are the subjects of (other) MDAs not having the capacity nor expertise to undertake them.
- Implementation of projects having cross-cutting themes, such as growth, which would not fit within a single MDA.

The intended start date is January 2025 and the anticipated duration is 15 weeks.
