In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electric Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

The Development Bank of Jamaica Limited, on behalf of the Ministry of Justice, has received funding from the Inter-American Development Bank and the Government of Jamaica, and intends to procure the services of a qualified firm or consortium of experts as Transaction Advisors to structure and execute a Judicial Court Complex for Trelawny via Public-Private Partnership (PPP). The Development Bank of Jamaica now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. A Consulting Firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies or the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank GN-2350-9, and the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Sector Procurement Procedures. The tender is open to all eligible and qualified bidders as defined in the Inter-American Development Bank policies.

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The Transaction Advisor will comprise of a team which includes Financial, Technical, Legal, Engineering, Architectural, Environmental and Social Consultants, managed by a team lead. The lead advisor should be a Financial Expert. In the first stage interested consulting firms will be shortlisted on the basis of their experience and expertise to deliver the required services.
