SUPPLIER FREE VIRTUAL TRAINING SERIES OCTOBER 2023-FEBRUARY 2024

EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

The Westmoreland Municipal Corporation invites bids from eligible and suitably qualified contractors for the procurement of: **The rehabilitation of Shrewsbury Housing Scheme Roads (Phase 2), Petersfield Division.**

Scope of Works: This work shall consist of the rehabilitation of the roads within Shrewsbury Housing Scheme, to include but not limited to procuring and furnishing all necessary material, equipment and labour to undertake: the preparation of formation; application of base material; demolish and reconstruct kerb & channel drains; demolish and reconstruct kerb walls; construct concrete 'u' drains; construct water drain grilles; construct head walls; clean earth drains; clean concrete 'u' drains; M.C. oil & sand; asphaltting of roadway; erect stop signs & support; erect street name plate (double) & support and place 200mm width junction stop line as directed.

Eligibility Requirements: (1) Copy of valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or Tax Compliance Letter (TCL); (2) Proof of registration with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) of Jamaica as a Public Sector Contractor in the category of Civil Engineering Works or General Roadworks, grade 2.

Availability: A complete set of Bidding Documents in English will be available for download as of **Tuesday, December 10, 2024** on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement website at www.gojep.gov.jm. Registration instructions will be available on the website listed on the system. Registration is required for vendors to participate in the Tender.

Submission Deadline: Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm no later than **Friday, January 24, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Jamaica time** and bids must be valid for One Hundred and Twenty (120) calendar days after the date of bid submission. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened online on **Friday, January 24, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. Jamaica time.**

This is an online managed Tender, and Tender Documents and Supplier Bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government Electronic Procurement Portal (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copy) bids will be accepted and there will be no physical Tender Box for drop-off Bids. To participate in this tender opportunity, Suppliers must first be registered and know how to use the Electronic Procurement System, www.gojep.gov.jm.
