EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT (GOJEP) SYSTEM

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen, promote and enhance the Public Procurement system, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP), has officially mandated the use of the e-Procurement System for procurement transactions exceeding One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (\$1,500,000.00), effective as of August 01, 2023. Suppliers interested in conducting business with the Government of Jamaica are now required to access and submit procurement documents through the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement (GOJEP) system. The OPPP is providing continuous and dedicated support to suppliers, and is pleased to announce the commencement of its annual free virtual supplier training series for the 2023-24 financial year. All interested suppliers are encouraged to partake in this initiative. Virtual sessions will run from October 2023-February 2024.

These sessions are designed to empower participants with the knowledge and skills required to effectively support the navigating, administering and managing of the GOJEP system. Each session is four (4) hours in length, and integrates interactive discussions, covering topics such as supplier self-registration, electronic bid submission and supplier account management.

Eligible bidders are invited to submit bids via the GOJEP to carry out the **Proposed Construction of Boundary/Security Fence at Retirement Primary School – St. Elizabeth.**

Scope: The scope of works includes but not limited to the following:

- Demolition of defective fence
- Excavation
- Installation of new chain-link fence
- Construction of block wall
- Concrete & form work.

The Government of Jamaica/Ministry of Health & Wellness, through the Kingston Public Hospital Rehabilitation Project, intends to undertake consulting services for contract award for a **Project Manager for the Kingston Public Hospital Redevelopment Project for a contract duration of Twenty-Four (24) months.**

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONSULTANCY

The services of a Project Manager will be required to manage the KPH redevelopment project to ensure the timely and effective rehabilitation. Responsibilities will involve working closely with Oversight Committee and the Technical team, the South East Regional Health Authorities (SERHA), private service providers and international development partners to determine and implement appropriate arrangements for the rehabilitation of KPH which also includes the transfer of the Oncology and Nephrology Unit to the St. Joseph's Hospital, which are the primary focus of the project.

QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and experience to perform the Services. The consultant should satisfy the following requirements:

- (i) Bachelor's Degree in Construction, Civil Engineering or Equivalent
- (ii) Project Management training and certification (preferably PMP Certification)
- (iii) At least five (5) years' experience coordinating or managing infrastructure projects
- (iv) A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or Tax Compliance Letter (TCL).
