BACKGROUND

The Government of Jamaica recently received funding support from the Green Climate Fund (GCF) through UNOPS to strengthen the climate adaptation action framework. This is to be attained through implementation of the Towards a comprehensive national adaptation planning process in Jamaica (Ja-NAP) Project.

Ja-NAP Project is geared towards strengthening the national adaptation planning and implementation framework through four outcomes that focus on (i) adaptation planning governance and institutional strengthening; (ii) design of adaptation solutions; (iii) engagement of the private sector; and (iv) increased access to adaptation financing.

Job Summary

The objective of this assignment is to support the Ja-NAP Project Management Unit, PIOJ and the Climate Change Division (CCD) in the implementation of the project's communications strategy and action plan and ensuring a gender inclusive, systematic and participatory approach to national adaptation planning.

Main Responsibilities

- Familiarise him/herself with the climate change and climate information communications landscape and implement the project's communication strategy and action plan.
- Assist the project team and CCD in conceptualizing, writing, and editing communications
 materials targeted at key stakeholders within the public and private sectors, civil society
 organizations and academia and liaise with media production personnel etc.
- Coordinate and collaborate with stakeholders to identify information deficits and conduct awareness raising programmes about the Ja-NAP Project and climate change adaptation using a range of media options including social media and other methods of communication, considering social inclusion particularly accessibility across gender, age (youth and elderly), persons with disability, and other social groups.
- Liaise with Corporate Marketing and Communication Division at the PIOJ, CCD and with media outlets to share info on the project and build NAP process awareness.
- Coordinate and conduct two capacity building and coordination workshops targeting communicators (journalists and media representatives) on climate change adaptation and resilience building highlighting gender and other areas of inclusion.
- Develop knowledge products including a Communication for Adaptation Planning: Jamaica Context Report.
- Serve as the project liaison and receive and process or elevate any complaints made against the project using the PIOJ Complaints Mechanism.
- Prepare quarterly and other reports on the project.
