Consultancy to establish Child Protection Committees

The objective of the Consultancy is to support the CPFSA in its efforts to establish a network of Child Protection Committees (CPC) operations – 1 CPC located in each Parish; across the island. In consultation with key stakeholders, the Consultant will carry out research and assessment; prepare and implement a plan of action/proposed programme of activities that will establish the most effective operational system for delivering the services intended by the CPC network.

Child Protection Committees

It is intended that Child Protection Committees (CPC) operate as the key local bodies for developing and implementing child protection strategies across and between agencies, local authorities and citizens' groups. The focus of these committees is to identify risk and develop and execute preventative strategies in response to current, new or emerging issues impacting children.

Eligibility Criterion

Copy of valid Tax Compliance Letter –TCL

Qualification:

Among other skills and competencies (more clearly outlined in the bid documents) the project seeks to identify experts that fulfil the below criteria and have demonstrated ability of involving key stakeholders to provide relevant expertise and bring a wider perspective in carrying-out Socio-economic Research and Assessment work.

- 1) Postgraduate or equivalent qualification in social sciences, statistics, development, and/or planning.
- 2) Demonstrated knowledge and professional work experience in carrying out social research and preparation of assessment/evaluation reports.
- 3) Demonstrated knowledge and professional work experience in planning, design and implementation of child protection and care systems/solutions.
