Description of Service: The works consist of the construction, testing, sterilization and commissioning into service of approximately 1.0Km of 250mm (10") nominal diameter ductile iron (DI) Transmission main from Morant Bay Main Road Intersection facility to the Stanton Storage Tank with the provision for numerous appurtenances of stated Contract Specifications and Conditions.

Eligibility Requirements:

Tenderers must submit:
