Tenderers must submit:

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or Tax Compliance Letter TCL), and must form part of the uploaded Bid submission and valid at the Bid submission deadline.
- A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the following category and must form part of the uploaded Bid submission and valid at the Bid submission deadline:
 - √ Safety Products
- Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
- Bid security in the correct amount and form
- A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the company's bid is not signed by a CEO, General Manager, Director, Managing Director of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid Document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal - GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Tender documents can be downloaded as of Wednesday, May 7, 2025.
- Clarification period no later than 7 working days (Monday, May 26, 2025) before bid submission deadline.

Submission Deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via the GOJEP no later than **Wednesday**, **June 4**, **2025**.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by **Thursday**, **June 5**, **2025** at the following address:
