Eligible bidders are invited to submit bids via the GOJEP to carry out the **Proposed Construction of Boundary/Security Fence at Ebenezer Primary School – Manchester.**

Scope: The scope of works includes but not limited to the following:

- Demolition of defective fence
- Excavation
- Installation of new chain-link fence
- Construction of block wall
- Concrete & form work.
