A financial audit of the funds provided by the CDC must be performed under GAGAS, or other approved standards where applicable, and accordingly includes such tests of the accounting records as deemed necessary under the circumstances.

Bidding will be conducted through the Restrictive Bidding (RB) Procedures specified in the Government of Jamaica's procurement policies.
