Consultant to Develop Training Modules and to Conduct Training Activities for Life Stage Approach to Health Promotion & Prevention: Primary Health Care Reform

The Life Approach is about recognizing key stages in life and the important health needs of each stage. The MOHW is moving towards patient centric care as a central pillar in primary health care. The Life approach will be used as the tool that will focus the health care provider on key health issues for health education and prevention for each client. This means that at each encounter with the client in the primary care setting, the health provider will not only manage the specific reason for the visit, but will also provide life stage specific health education and screening.

This approach seeks to increase the health literacy of the population by familiarizing them with the different health needs at each stage in life. In educating the individual on their health needs at their life stage, it is anticipated that the client will also be exposed to the continuum of services required as they move from one stage to the next.

Objective of the Consultancy

The consultant shall develop and prepare training modules presented in a comprehensive narrative document that is to be disseminated to the field, powerpoint presentations for training purposes, and powerpoint presentations formatted for access via a virtual training platform for the Life Stage Approach to Health Promotion & Protection.

Scope of work

In undertaking this assignment, the consultant is required to:

- 1) Develop training modules
- Develop and package the information on each health topic and screening for each of the five life stages, in a narrative format, so that the health care provider is sufficiently knowledgeable to discuss the topics with the client.
- Develop PowerPoint presentations for each health topic, to be used for training.
- 4) Prepare information for virtual access for training.
- 5) Develop and conduct pre and post-tests.
- Conduct training for health care providers.
- Work with the focal points in the MOHW.
- Conduct appropriate literature review on the content for the training materials.
- Other tasks as directed by the Chief Medical Officer or Primary Health Care Reform Project
