This invitation for prequalification is a part of the International Competitive Bidding process for the project.

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has secured funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) (Loan No. 2658/OC-JA) to implement the Fiscal Administration Modernization Programme (FAMP), which involves the Modernization and Strengthening of Tax Administration, Customs, Public Debt Management and the Central Treasury Management System (CTMS). The Ministry of Finance & the Public Service (MOFPS) is the executing agency for the FAMP, and a part of the proceeds of the loan is to be applied to **Consulting Services for the Renovation and Upgrading of the Montego Bay Revenue Service Centre ('MoBay RSC') Building**, 18b Howard Cooke Boulevard, Montego Bay.

Selection will be conducted in accordance with the procedures specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN-2350-9), and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Policies.

Description of Works

MoBay RSC is a two-storey building with a basement of approximately 32,600 ft² total gross space, constructed from reinforced concrete, with parking in the basement and on the ground level. An additional wing (Annex) was built which houses the standby generator, canteen, and caretaker's quarters. This building was constructed in the early 1990s and when renovated is to continue to house the operations of the MoBay RSC, but in an enhanced ergonomic environment.

Besides general repair/refurbishment and upgrading of utilities, a key objective of the project is the reconfiguration of existing space to comport with revised work processes and flows, staff population and customer traffic and service flows, permitting optimally efficient use of the facility.

The works to be undertaken include: stripping out, decommissioning and legal disposal of redundant fixtures, plant and equipment; any necessary structural reinforcement and remedial foundation works; rectification of roof defects; expansion of usable space within existing footprint of building; building storage area at back of building; remodelling of canteen; complete rewiring of the building, including provision of individually controlled electrical supplies to each floor; energy efficient lighting control; replacement of electrical fixtures; provision of structured cabling for voice, data, and power; provision of UPS for ICT and auxiliary services; provision of fire detection and suppression system; provision of centrally controlled electronic security system to include alarm, access control and CCTV; repair and/or replacement of bathroom fixtures; replacement of windows with energy efficient solution, ventilation option; repainting; scouring (cutting) of floors; partitioning; provision of furniture; provision of hurricane shutters; provision of an elevator.

Shortlisting of Firms

MOFPS now invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from eligible and capable firms to provide the required Consulting Services, including design, costing, preparation of bidding documents, bid evaluation, contract administration, and supervision of works to completion.

Eligible firms will be shortlisted on the basis of the following criteria:

- Local bidders must possess a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)
- Composition of team
- Qualifications of principal
- Qualifications of other team members
- Relevant experience of firm and team
- Financial capacity (adequacy for the engagement)
- Suggestions for improving functionality of building.

Shortlisted firms will be sent the Request for Proposals (RFP), to enable selection of the Consultant.

EOIs must be emailed to Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), at the address below, **no later than Wednesday September 27, 2017**.
