TITLE: NATIONAL CRAFT POLICY AND STRATEGY FOR JAMAICA

BACKGROUND

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Tourism and Entertainment, aims to develop a **National Craft Policy & Strategy for Jamaica** that will facilitate:

1. A strengthened and competitive craft sector with enhanced initiatives and products throughout the value chain;
2. An Improved operational and infrastructural system and structure that will lead to sophistication of the products and services, and increased productivity;
3. An effective governance framework for the development and promotion of the craft sector;
4. The promotion of Authentic Jamaican craft products and cultural experiences to strengthen Jamaica's cultural capital;
5. The development of supporting infrastructure to build capacity of personnel in all aspects of craft production.

OBJECTIVE OF THE CONSULTANCY

The objective of the consultancy is the development of the National Craft Policy and Strategy for Jamaica.

SCOPE OF WORK

In furtherance of the policy development process, the Consultant will be expected to, among other tasks:

- Define the policy scope including defining the significance of craft within the context of Jamaica's craft and tourism development;
- Conduct meetings and consultations with key Ministries, Departments, Agencies, and craft related educational and training institutions, craft practitioners and key stakeholders to inform policy development;
- Present a succinct Situational Analysis;
- Define Authentic Jamaican Craft;
- Conduct a Gap Analysis;
- Locate, within the policy, a Craft Authority as a key strategy and mechanism for the governance, development and growth of the Jamaican craft industry.
