Rehabilitation of Jacques Road Multi-Purpose Centre

The Government of Jamaica through the Ministry of National Security (MNS) and with financing from the Inter-American Development Bank, the UK Department for International Development (DFID) and the Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development (DFATD) of Canada is implementing the Citizen Security and Justice Programme III (CSJP III). The programme seeks to enhance citizen security and justice in fifty (50) volatile and vulnerable communities across eight parishes. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the funding will be applied to eligible payments for this civil works.
