NEPA is inviting proposals for consultancy to **conduct a feasibility assessment, to establish and manage a National Wildlife Reserve to assist with recovery strategies for endangered and vulnerable species in Westmoreland, Jamaica.**

Construction period is four (4) months.

Bid No. (6140): FLANKER PELE DRIVE DRAINAGE AND ROAD CONSTRUCTION - ST. JAMES. The works include the construction of a silt trap and spillway, construction of a retaining wall, construction of paved water way/ road, construction of rip rap, and installation of concrete culvert and the erection of a gabion basket. Construction period is four (4) months.
