To remove corrosion, clean and apply primer and top coat to entire surface area of 23 wind turbine towers with dimension of:

Height	50m
Top Diameter	2.564m
Bottom Diameter	3.503m

#### Contractor must:

- Provide his own nylon guide rope length no less than 100m with diameter of 5cm and be prepared to use the sky climber supplied by Wigton Windfarm Limited (WWFL) under the supervision of a trained WWFL staff member. The guide rope is to be managed by the supplier's employees
- Provide antifungal paint (suitable for metal) for use in a highly saline environment and state the paint specification
- Specify duration of work and contingency to complete job
