The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the **Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)** to assist in financing the **Agricultural Competitiveness Programme (ACP)** being implemented by the **Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries**. The Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries now invites sealed proposals for **Water Based Environmental Analysis Consultancy at our established Agro Parks**. The RFP is being governed by the IADB's procurement policy GN-2350-9

Scope: The Consultant is required to monitor the impact of chemical usage within the agro-parks and the surrounding environment, on the water quality, through periodic sampling and analytical laboratory testing in order to monitor the specific water quality within the parks. The contract will have duration of **one (1) year** and will require coordination with the **National Irrigation Commission (NIC)** for collection of samples from their potable supply wells.
