The scope of work involves the demolition and re-construction of the auditorium/annex building, renovation of the two (2) bathroom blocks (infant and upper school), demolition and re-construction of the infant school classrooms block and construction of chain-link fence. **Construction period is three (3) months.**

The scope of work involves the construction of a new Early Childhood Development Centre with three (3) fully equipped classrooms each having its own bathroom. The facility will also include a kitchen and canteen, one sickbay, one adult lavatory, an administrative area, construction of a playground and the erection of a perimeter fence to enclose the school. The integrated community space will have a newly constructed multi-purpose court (to include netball, basketball, tennis and cricket pitch) and scrimmage field which will be enclosed by a perimeter fence. **Construction period is three (3) months.**

Bid No. (6444): GIBLATORE PRIMARY SCHOOL REHABILITATION AND SANITATION, ST. CATHERINE (#073305). The scope of work includes the construction of two (2) sanitation blocks, each block having four toilets/face basin for the students (4 urinals for the male bathrooms) and two toilet/face basin for the staff. The works will also include roof repairs, partitioning of classrooms, electrical re-wiring, supply and installation of windows and doors, installation of cupboards, countertops and an additional sink in the kitchen. Construction of 400m chain-link fence, supply and installation of six (6) 1,000 gallons water tanks along with pump on a concrete tank base, supply and installation of rain water guttering, paving of the school ground and general painting of the building. **Construction period is three (3) months.**
